Representative Matters

Obtained a defense verdict in a jury trial involving three plaintiffs in a motor vehicle accident despite admitting liability, which was affirmed on appeal.

Obtained affirmance by the Kentucky Court of Appeals of summary judgment in a claim by the estate of a breathing machine–dependent ALS patient who died when his power was disconnected.

Obtained summary judgment dismissing claim against supplier of ingredient in nutritional supplement that was alleged to have caused liver failure of 23-year-old woman. Manufacturer and seller of supplement remained in case.
